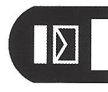

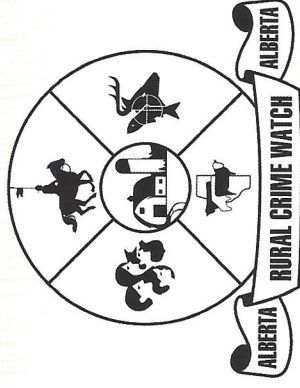

Procedure to Follow In The Event of a Crime:

- 1) If the suspect is gone, call 403-885-3333 and report the crime.
- 2) If the crime is in progress and the suspect is still present, notify police immediately by dialing 911.
- 3) Do not approach any suspect, vehicle or suspicious activity.
- 4) Record any and all information of the suspicious activity such as descriptions of person(s) vehicle(s) and license plate number(s)

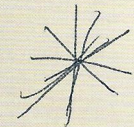
